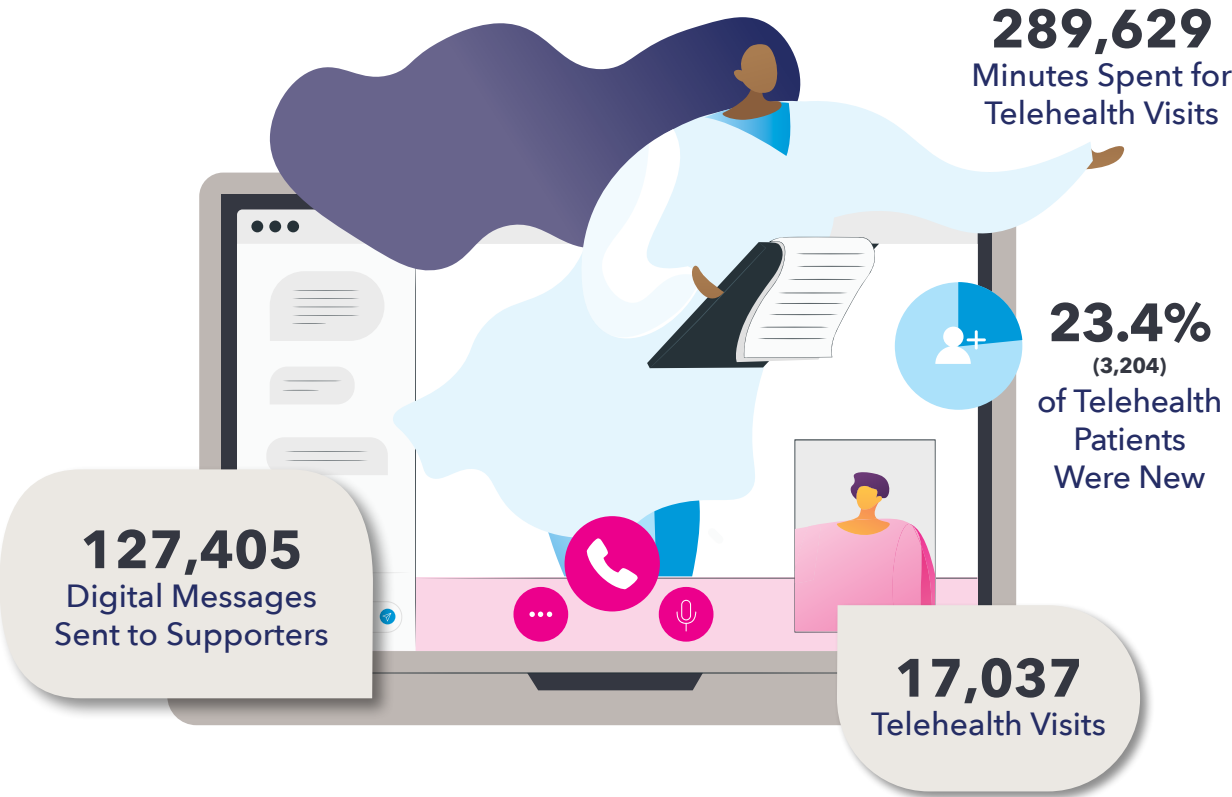

Showing Up in New Ways to a Changing World

Like so many other organizations, PPSNE had to reimagine its operations and all mission work this past year to respond to the COVID-19 pandemic. Your generous support enabled us to quickly transform the ways we reach patients, activists, and young people in a world where being together in person often felt like a distant dream. **With your partnership, we found new ways to stay connected, including online education programs, telehealth visits, and virtual volunteer events.**

Education and Training moved into the exciting world of digital education, conducting all programs online this year. **With new expertise in online learning, educators explored the advantages of digital programs to form new connections with youth.** By allowing youth to participate on their schedule and from any location, our impact grew beyond our expectations.

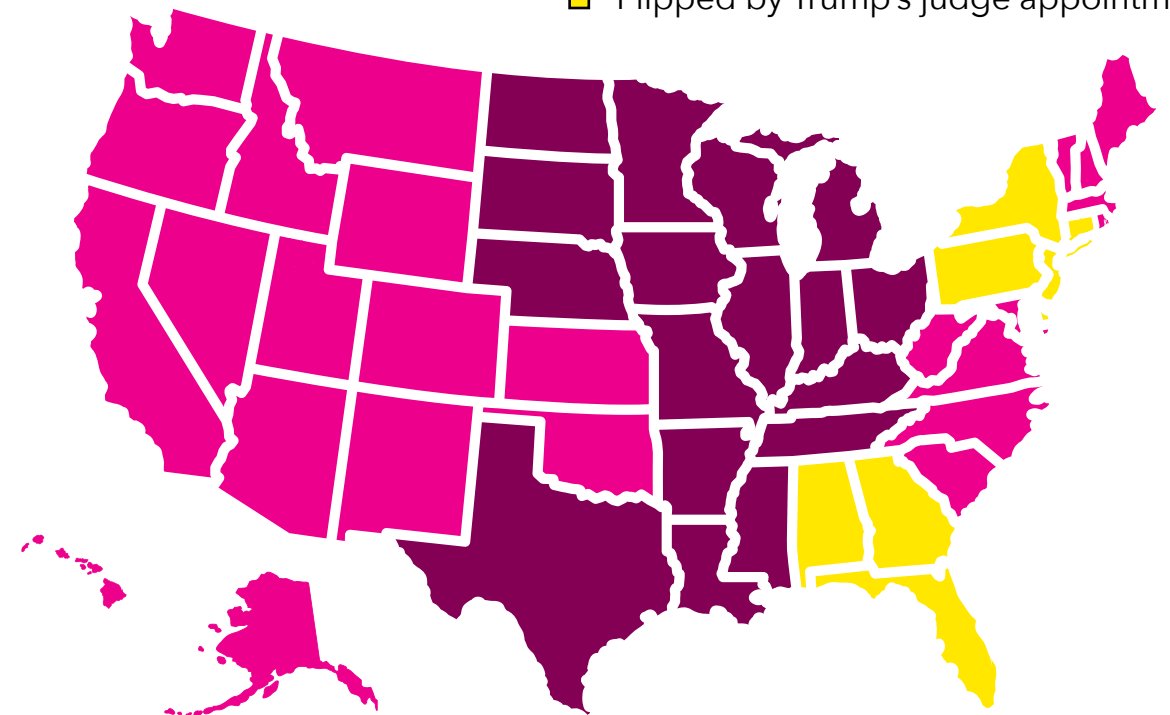

We are living through the culmination of a decades-long, coordinated strategy to erode the constitutional right to abortion. This strategic effort to pack the federal courts – from district courts all the way to the Supreme Court – with anti-abortion judges puts the settled case law of *Roe v. Wade* in grave danger of being overturned or severely eroded.

OUR CALLING, OUR MISSION

The clock is being turned back as we speak. With the possibility of the constitutional right to abortion stripped away, the work to protect access to abortion now must happen on the state level. **Our mission is in sharp focus: To ensure all Connecticut and Rhode Island residents can access critically needed health care at PPSNE, including abortion.** Despite the shifting nature of the pandemic, our health centers continued providing care, keeping people out of hospitals and hard-hit health systems. Supporters helped reduce the impact of the loss of critical Title X funding so that services remain accessible and affordable for patients.

Because Rhode Island state law bans Medicaid and state employee coverage for abortion, there are many more patients in Rhode Island who depend on our abortion assistance fund. Thanks to you, we can provide our patients with the abortion care they deserve.

LIFTING PATIENT VOICES

People deserve access to abortion without shame and stigma. **Centering the stories of patient advocates and their supporters honors and elevates the experiences of those who seek abortion.** This is critical in shaping the public narrative and reducing abortion stigma.

Equipping social service providers with the language, tools, and understanding to talk about abortion is essential to reduce abortion stigma in our communities. PPSNE educators train staff from different social service agencies on how to counsel their clients about options for unintended pregnancies using medically accurate information and non-stigmatizing language. **Each conversation is a way to break down the silence that feeds abortion stigma.**

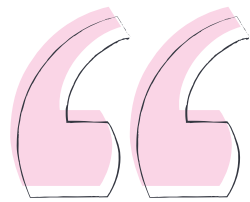

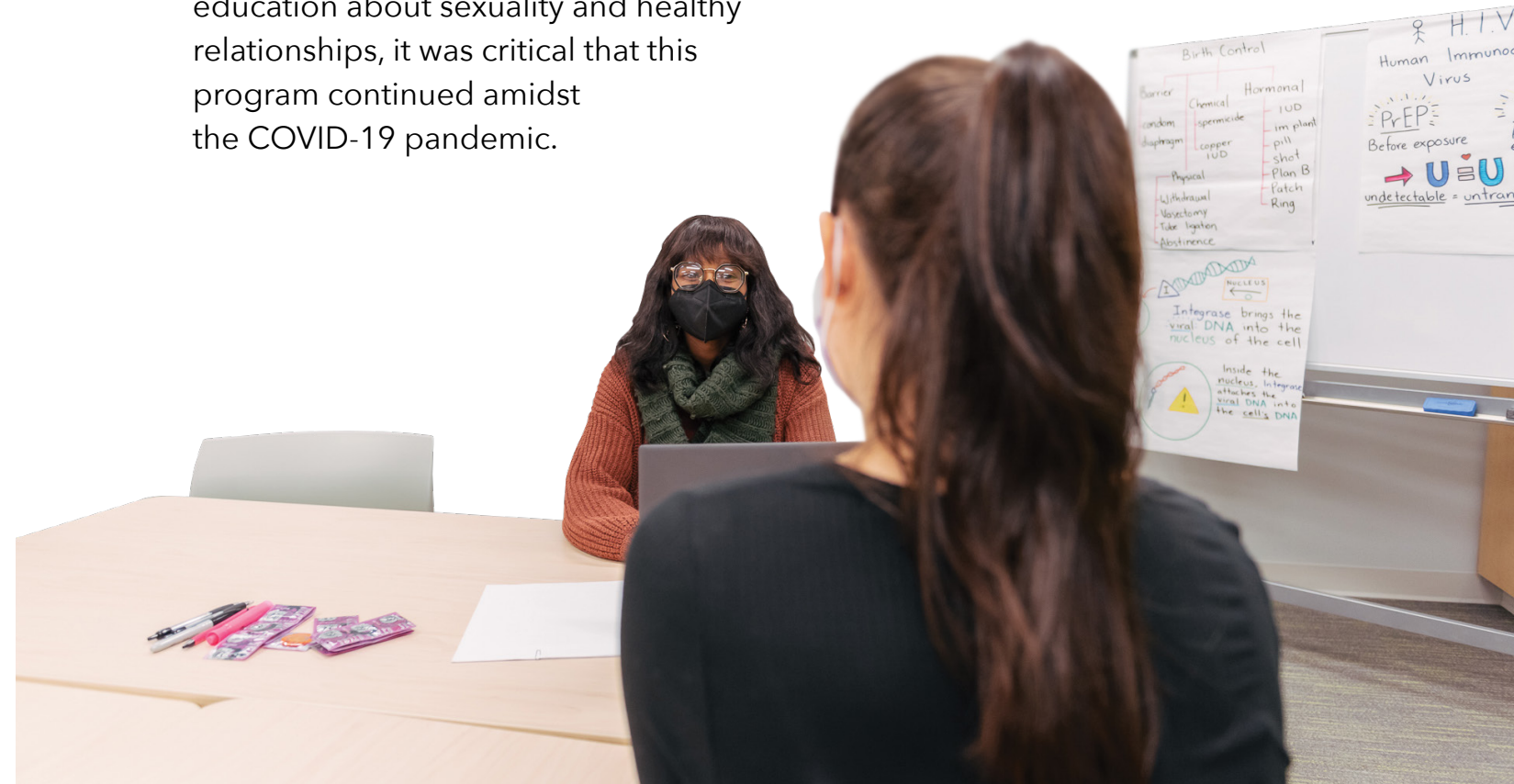
SEX ED FOR ALL

PPSNE educators ensure every person has equitable access to the tools and information they need to live healthy lives. In a long-standing partnership with the Connecticut Department of Developmental Services (DDS), educators teach a "Healthy Relationships" workshop series for adults with intellectual and developmental disabilities. Due to COVID-19, this program shifted to the virtual space, where online learning expanded access to this much needed education. **Virtual sessions eliminated traditional barriers, like transportation, and allowed those who sometimes are uncomfortable with new faces or large gatherings to participate.** As a community that often does not receive comprehensive education about sexuality and healthy relationships, it was critical that this program continued amidst the COVID-19 pandemic.

POLICY VICTORIES FOR EQUITY

During the 2021 legislative sessions and in coalition with community partners, both states passed policies to advance racial equity and health equity:



Connecticut passed a policy that formally declared **racism a public health crisis and centers the impact of racism**. This policy shift redirects much-needed resources to address racial health care disparities in the state, including in maternal and breast health and defining the doula profession in state law.



In Rhode Island, the Doula Reimbursement Act became law – **a celebration of the work led by Black doulas and community partners to make doula care more accessible that we were proud to support**.

DOULAS are trained perinatal care professionals who provide informational, physical, emotional and advocacy support for pregnant people and their families. Doulas are non-medical support people who are experienced in navigating the twists and turns of this complex time, helping to provide resources and support. Evidence strongly suggests that the presence of a doula significantly improves birth and postpartum outcomes and mitigates the racial disparities in parental and fetal morbidity and mortality.

GENDER-AFFIRMING HORMONE THERAPY

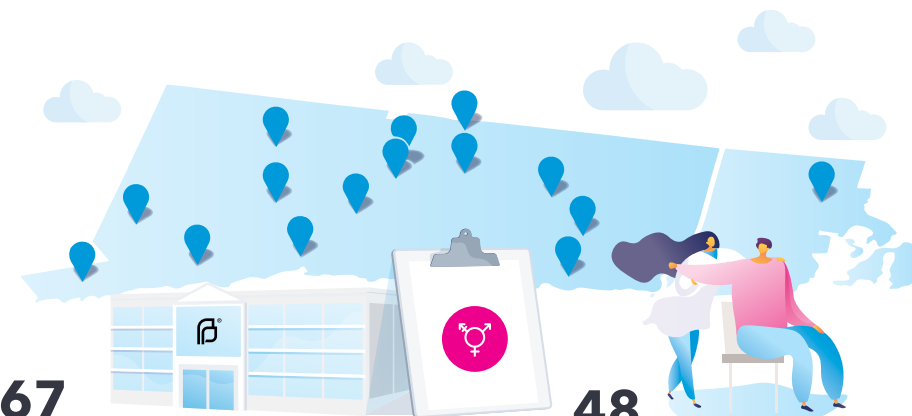
(GAHT) aims to align a person's physical characteristics with their gender identity and expression through medication. People who undergo GAHT often identify as transgender - a term that includes the many ways someone's gender identity does not match the sex they were assigned at birth.

ACCESS TO CARE FOR ALL

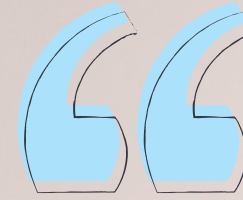
Patients who are transgender or non-binary face tremendous barriers to accessing care, and the pandemic worsened this health equity issue. Throughout COVID-19, PPSNE clinicians continued to provide patients with gender-affirming hormone therapy using telehealth. We found that telehealth visits for hormone therapy expanded access in Connecticut and Rhode Island, where PPSNE is one of few providers accepting Medicaid for hormone therapy.

Within a health care system where racism, homophobia, and transphobia persist, your support enabled access to this life-saving health care that affirms and respects all patients' identities.

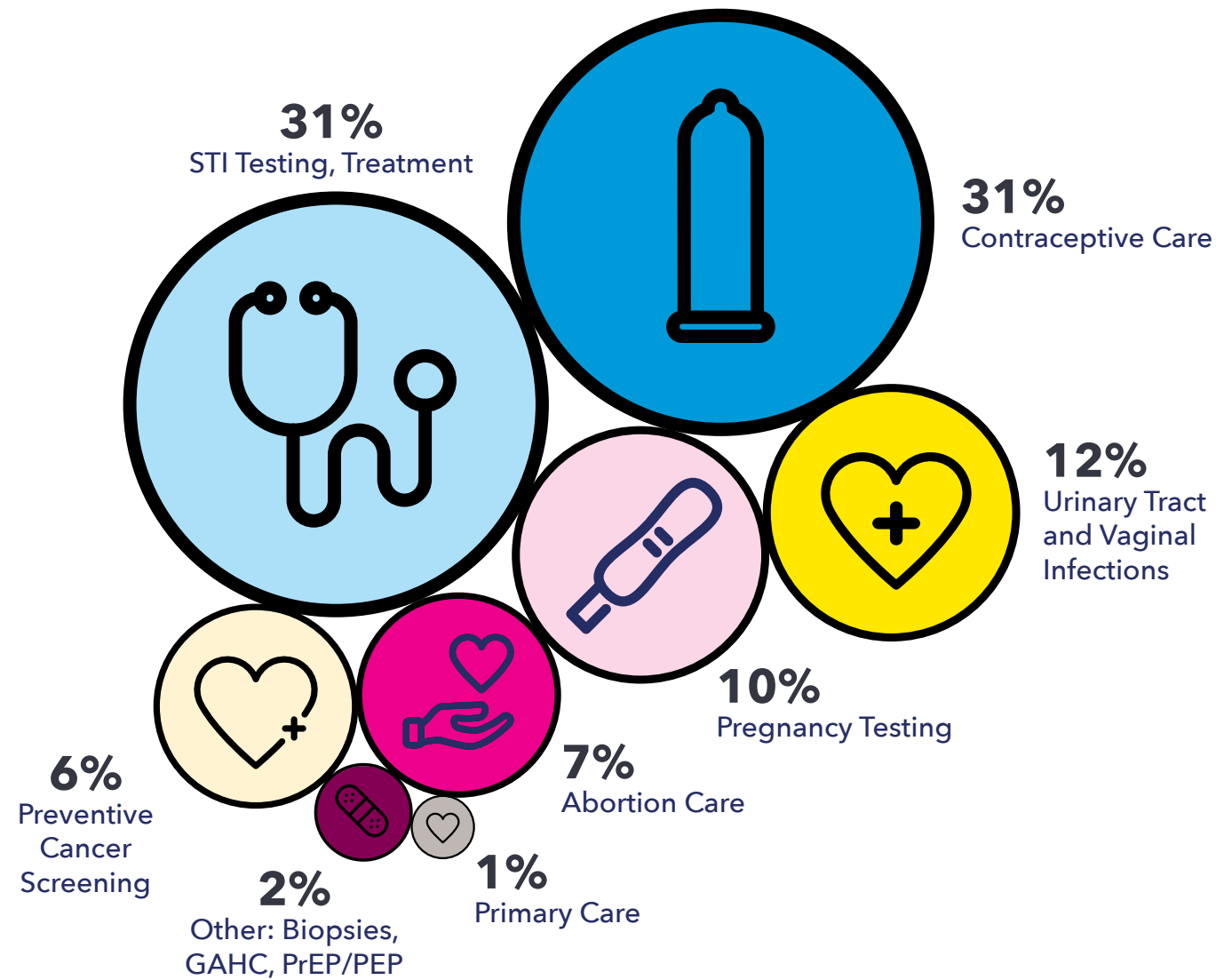

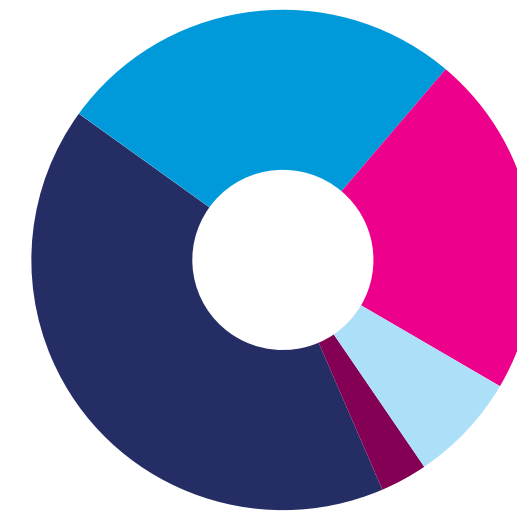
Service Type Breakdown
