



✓ Vote by Mail is Safe

5% of all votes cast in 2022 came from the **11 Nebraska counties** that run their elections entirely by mail



Military and overseas voters have long been able to cast their votes by mail

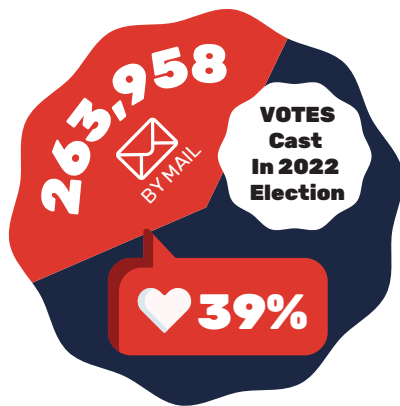
Only **1%** of mail in votes in the last election were **rejected**



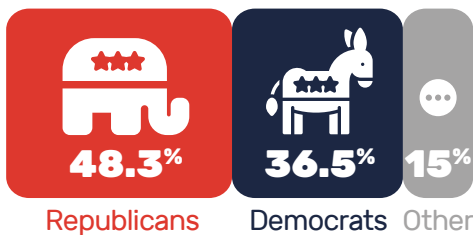
Mail systems for tracking ballots like barcodes and signature requirements help ensure that no fraudulent voting is possible. **There is no evidence that fraudulent mail voting has ever occurred in Nebraska.**

✓ Vote by Mail is Popular

Average voter turnout was nearly **20 points higher** in Nebraska's all mail counties than the state as a whole



Voters of **all parties** use vote by mail

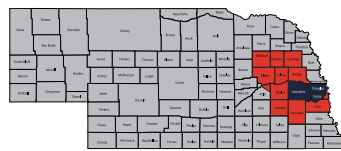


Partisan turnout did not change when Nebraska counties switched to all mail elections¹

✓ Vote by Mail is Statewide

Voters in **all Congressional districts** use vote by mail



Vote by mail is widely used in both rural and urban parts of the state. The five non all mail counties that had the most voters voting by mail were Harlan, Gage, Wayne, Douglas, and Thayer



What if I prefer to vote in person? Would LB 365 make me vote by mail?



LB365 would extend the **option** to conduct all mail elections to any county in Nebraska regardless of population. It would **NOT** require any county to conduct an all mail election. LB365 would increase flexibility and local control over elections for our counties.
